



MEDEX PLUS

Emergency Medical Evacuation Program

Did you know that as a Marathon Coach Club International member you're entitled to receive FMCA's MEDEX PLUS emergency medical coverage? Travel medical insurance provides peace of mind, knowing that you are covered should an emergency occur.

First offered to FMCA family members in 2001, the MEDEX PLUS Emergency Medical Program provides basic emergency medical assistance benefits and other travel assistance services to members that are 100 or more miles away from home. The 24/7/365 coverage is available within the United States, Canada, and Mexico.

Summary of Benefits:

- Emergency Medical Air and Ground Evacuation: Medically supervised evacuation to the nearest appropriate facility if a member is involved in an accident or suffers a sudden, unforeseen illness.
- Return Home of Unattended Grandchildren and Dependent Children: Transportation home for a member's children or grandchildren left unattended in the event of a member's accident, illness, or death.

- RV and Automobile Returned Home: Return of a member's drivable vehicle to his or her residence (or return of a rental vehicle) if the member is unable to operate the vehicle.
- Transportation to Join a Hospitalized Member (*for members traveling alone and hospitalized for seven days or more*): The transportation of a family member or friend to visit an FMCA member who is hospitalized for seven days or more.
- Transportation Home after Initial Evacuation: The transportation of a member to the point of origin or permanent residence following an emergency evacuation.
- Repatriation of Remains: The return of a member's remains in the event of death.

With the exception of transportation to join a hospitalized member, which has a limit of \$1,000, all other services carry no limit to the cost that will be paid by MEDEX.
