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Early Arrival Monday, October 18

Free early arrival sites after 1:00 pm for all attendees at Fort Wilderness Resort & Campground at Walt Disney World® in Lake Buena Vista, Florida. All sites have 50-amp electrical and water/sewer hookups. *Note: Because the rally officially begins on Tuesday, there is nothing on Monday’s schedule except afternoon meetings/work sessions for those who volunteer to help with things such as welcome preparations, Tuesday’s rally registration, and decorating. Because we will need help parking coaches beginning Sunday, October 17, those who can arrive on Saturday, October 16 or Sunday, October 17 are more than welcome (check-in time both days is 1:00 pm or later).*
