## Early Arrival

### Tuesday, August 25

Free early arrival sites for all attendees at Marathon Coach in Coburg, Oregon: ([www.marathoncoach.com](http://www.marathoncoach.com)), where attendees will camp in the parking lot with 50-amp service. **Note:** Because the rally officially begins on Wednesday, there is nothing on Tuesday's schedule except some afternoon meetings/work sessions for those helping with things such as parking, Wednesday's rally registration, and decorating the tent.

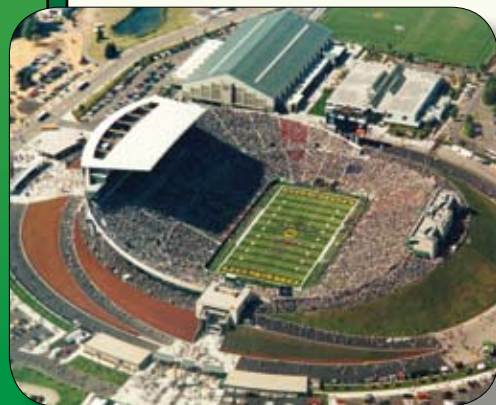
### Day 4 Saturday, August 29
