## Preliminary Rally Itinerary

Some say that today Nashville has the greatest concentrated collection in the world of songwriters, singers, studios, and musicians. Today's global songwriters and performers flock to Nashville for its preeminent recording studios, technical artistry, industry, and financial incentives and expertise. "Nashville Music" will delve into this fascinating scene by scheduling experiences with it all.



### Early Arrival Monday, May 21

Free early arrival full hook-up sites are available on Monday, May 21 at 1:00 pm at Yogi Bear's Jellystone Park, 2572 Music Valley Drive, Nashville, Tennessee, 37214. The park's features include free wireless Internet, an outdoor pool, a camp store with car rental, and a grocery store. **Please note: Because the rally officially begins on Tuesday, there is nothing on Monday's schedule except afternoon meetings/work sessions for those who volunteer to help with things such as welcome preparations, Tuesday's rally registration, and decorating. Because we will need help parking coaches beginning Sunday, May 20, those who can arrive on Saturday, May 19 or Sunday, May 20 are more than welcome (check-in time both days is 2:00 pm or later).**

- Rally Registration in the Park's Pavilion (9:30 am-1:30 pm)
- Board of Directors' Meeting in the Park's Activity Office (11:00 am - 12:30 pm)
- On-Site Welcome Social for First-Timers with Club Management in the Park's Pavilion (5:30-6:00 pm)
- Welcome All Attendees to the "Nashville Music" Rally Social & Dinner in the Park's Pavilion. Entertainment this Evening is "Nashville Rock versus Nashville Country." (6:00-9:00 pm)





## **Day 2** **Wednesday, May 23**

- Choose from One of Three Nashville Tour Options (*all tours are 10:00 am-2:30 pm and include lunch*):
  1. "Music & Antique Memorabilia." Attendees will do some sleuthing at the "American Pickers" new retail store, visit the historic Marathon Car Factory, and more.
  2. "Music Jam." A group of 12-16 attendees will work with a songwriter at a recording studio to create and record their own hit song.
  3. "Diners & Dives." This tour is a foodie's taste challenge: Attendees will visit some unique Nashville eateries and sample their fare.

- FREE EVENING: Note that the Grand Ole Opry is closed on Wednesday.



## **Day 3** **Thursday, May 24**

- "Breakfast Concert." This morning's special breakfast in the Pavilion will serve up not just delicious food, but also music favorites and easy to listen to tunes. (8:00-9:15 am)
- Prevost Service Center Lunch & "Prevost University" Mini "TechTalk" Sessions (12:00-3:30 pm at Prevost's Nashville Facility)
- Ladies' Luncheon at Manuel Cuevas American Designs Clothier Shop (12:00-2:30 pm)
- Musical Nashville Social & Dinner at the Prestigious Hermitage Hotel. Entertainment tonight will feature "Songwriters in the Round." Major songwriters and recording artists will come together for a "storytelling" show that's fun and highly interactive. (6:00-9:00 pm)



## **Day 4** **Friday, May 25**

- Today's a Free Day, or Participate in One of Two Optional Activities:
  1. Play Golf at Gaylord Springs Golf Links. Cost is \$120 per person and is not included in the rally fee. (9:00 am-2:00 pm)
  2. Be Part of a "Music Jam." A group of 12-16 attendees will work with a songwriter at a recording studio to create and record their own hit song. (*Note that this same activity is offered on Wednesday.*)
- FREE EVENING: You might want to consider attending a show this evening at the Grand Ole Opry. (*Note that this activity would be on your own.*)
